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NOTICE

CROSS CONNECTION CONTROL BACKFLOW PREVENTION

The Texas Commission of Environmental Quality and The City of White Oak require all backflow prevention assembly to be tested and inspected annually by a certified backflow prevention assembly tester. Test results must be filed with The City of White Oak. A service agreement must be signed by the homeowner before any work is performed and the homeowner must understand his/her responsible concerning backflow prevention control. The service agreement must be returned to the Building Inspection Department before the final connection is completed. (30 TAC 290.44)

IRRIGATION SERVICE AGREEMENT

I. **PURPOSE.** The City of White Oak is responsible for protecting the drinking water supply from contamination or pollution that could result from improper plumbing practices. The purpose of this service agreement is to notify each customer of the plumbing restrictions that are in place to provide this protection. The utility enforces these restrictions to ensure the public health and welfare. Each customer must sign this agreement before the City of White Oak will begin service. In addition, when service to an existing connection has been suspended or terminated, the water system will not re-establish service unless it has a signed copy of this agreement.

II. **PLUMBING RESTRICTIONS.** The following unacceptable plumbing practices are prohibited by State regulations.

- A. No direct connection between the public drinking water supply and a potential source of contamination is permitted. Potential sources of contamination shall be isolated from the public water system by an air-gap or an appropriate backflow prevention device.
- B. No cross-connection between the public drinking water supply and a private water system is permitted. These potential threats to the public drinking water supply shall be eliminated at the service connection by the installation of an air-gap or a reduced pressure-zone backflow prevention device.
- C. No connection that allows water to be returned to the public drinking water supply is permitted.
- D. No pipe or pipe fitting which contains more than 0.25% lead may be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection that provides water for human use.
- E. No solder of flux that contains more than 0.2 % lead can be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection that provides water for human use.

III. **SERVICE AGREEMENT.** The following are the terms of the service agreement between the City of White Oak (the Water System) and _____ (the Customer).

- A. The Water System will maintain a copy of this agreement as long as the Customer and/or the premises is connected to the Water System.
- B. The Customer shall allow his property to be inspected for possible cross-connections and other unacceptable plumbing practices. These inspections shall be conducted by the Water System or its designated agent prior to initiating new water service; when there is reason to believe that cross-connections or other unacceptable plumbing practices exist; or alter any major changes to the private plumbing facilities. The inspections shall be conducted during the Water System's normal business hours.
- C. The Water System shall notify the Customer in writing of any cross-connection or other unacceptable plumbing practice that has been identified during the initial inspection or the periodic re-inspection.
- D. The Customer shall immediately correct any unacceptable plumbing practice on his premises.
- E. The Customer shall, at his expense, properly install, test and maintain any backflow prevention device required by the Water System. Copies of all testing and maintenance records shall be provided to the Water System.

IV. **ENFORCEMENT.** If the Customer fails to comply with the terms of the Service Agreement, the Water System shall, at its option, either terminate service, or properly install, test and maintain an appropriate backflow prevention device at the service connection. Any expenses associated with the enforcement of the agreement shall be billed to the Customer.
