

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE OAK, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 10-42 OF THE CITY CODE TO REDUCE THE REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTANCE BETWEEN OCCUPIED BUILDINGS OR DWELLINGS AND ENCLOSED STRUCTURES FOR POULTRY OR OTHER DOMESTIC FOWL; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, after evaluating the requirements of Section 10-42 of the City Code, the City Council has determined that its distance standard between occupied buildings or dwellings and enclosed structures for poultry or other domestic fowl should be reduced; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE OAK, TEXAS:

ARTICLE I.

That Section 10-4 (3) of the White Oak City Code is amended to read as follows:

Section 10-42 -Keeping poultry and birds.

The following regulations shall govern the keeping of poultry and certain birds in the City:

(3) No poultry or other domestic fowl shall be kept in any enclosed structure within the City any part of which enclosed structure is within 25 feet of any occupied building or dwelling within the City.


ARTICLE II.

It shall be unlawful to violate any provision of this Ordinance. Violations of any provision of this Ordinance shall be punishable by fine not to exceed \$200.00. Each day that any violation of this Ordinance shall continue shall constitute a separate offense.


ARTICLE III.
