6. DISCUSSION of Fireworks in the Code of Ordinance Sec. 30-132

- Allow fireworks to be used during a time period. For example, 5pm until 10pm

The conclusion was that the Ordinance should be kept in effect and not changed. The council was unable to find a good/safe way to allow fireworks in the city limits.
